FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard upon the Husband's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, present RONALD L. SCHULTZ, Husband, and ERNEST P. JENKINS, ESQ., attorney for Husband . A default having been entered against the Wife on September 30, 1985, and the Court having taken testimony and having received into evidence a Marital Settlement Agreement and Amendment to Marital Settlement Agreement entered between the parties dated the 21st day of August, 1985, the Court finding that the parties entered into said Marital Settlement Agreement and Amendment to Marital Settlement Agreement freely and voluntarily, that the Husband has been a bona fide resident of the State of Florida for more than six (6) months immediately prior to the filing of the Petition, that the marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken, and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises; it is thereupon

2. The marriage between the Husband and Wife is hereby dissolved.
3. The Marital Settlement Agreement and Amendment to Marital Settlement Agreement entered between the parties, dated the 21st day of August, 1985, and introduced as evidence, is approved by the Court and incorporated into this Judgment by reference, and the parties are ordered to comply with the provisions thereof.


