Notes for Joseph Teacher:

James was a handyman who lived with Mary Carraway long before he married her. Their children Fred and Glennie were nine years old when James and Mary were married. James spent some time in the TB sanatorium around 1920. When he died there was no doctor attending so I don't know if that was the cause of death.

Notes for Mary Carraway:

Cause of Death- Interstitial nephritis (kidney related)
