(1) My place of residence is 1106 E. Holt Ave., Milwaukee, Wis. My occupation is Housewife  
(3) I was born in Kent, England on June 7, 1874 My race is English  
(4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on Aug. 19, 1936 in the Circuit Court of Milwaukee County, Wis., at Milwaukee, Wis.  
(5) I am married. The name of my wife or husband is Herman Nicholas Reese we were married on June 25, 1932 at Milwaukee, Wis.; he was born at Austin, Germany on Mar. 24, 1876; entered the United States at New York, N. Y. on 1883 for permanent residence therein, and now resides at Milwaukee, Wis. I have 7 children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows: William Joseph, born July 30, 1893; Joseph Henry, Nov. 27, 1895; Beatrice, Oct. 12, 1902; Jesse, Oct. 6, 1906; John Thomas, Jan. 25, 1910; Woodrow Wilson, Mar. 4, 1913; Catherine Margaret, Feb. 17, 1915; all children born, and now reside, in Milwaukee, Wis.  
(6) My last foreign residence was E. Greenwich, England I emigrated to the United States of America from Glasgow, Scotland My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, N. Y., under the name of Jane E. Savin on Sept. 1892, on the vessel State of California as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached hereto.

(9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since Sept. 1892 and in the County of Milwaukee this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since Sept. 1892, being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition.  
(10) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization: No. , on at and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:
