Mrs. J. E. Kennedy, 1102 20th St., died this morning at 8:50 o'clock at Mercy Hospital as the result of a lingering illness. She had been a patient for three months.

Mrs. Kennedy was formerly Miss Mary Grosnick, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Herman Grosnick. She was born at Shawano, July 11, 1881. She taught in the elementary public schools at Pulaski and Hilbert.
